Maximum 10 entries per classroom (if entering as individuals).

Collaborative projects are encouraged.

#### **Criteria for Judging**

Artistic creativity and originality .. (50%) Skillful use of 100% discarded or reused materials ..... (50%)

#### **Rules of Entry**

Art must be fabricated from 100% found, reused or recycled materials (excluding glue, paint, etc.).

All art must be display ready. Construction to be strong and secure.

All art must have a completed Registration Form attached.
