### Re-Create

Re-Create is a recycled art competition and traveling exhibition that is open to students (TK-12) attending Oakland Schools. Students are invited to create artwork using discarded or reused materials and compete for prizes.

### Eligibility

All students (TK-12) in Oakland schools.  
Original work - not previously exhibited.  
One entry per artist or per collaborative group.  
Maximum 10 entries per classroom (if entering as individuals).  
Collaborative projects are encouraged.

### Criteria for Judging

Artistic creativity and originality .. (50%)  
Skillful use of 100% discarded or reused materials ..... (50%)

### Rules of Entry

Art must be fabricated from 100% found, reused or recycled materials (excluding glue, paint, etc.).  
All art must be display ready. Construction to be strong and secure.  
All art must have a completed Registration Form attached.
