ATTEND

Participate in a seasonal cohort by attending 4 weekly classes over 1 month.

Week 1

- Defining sustainability and aligning your mission with sustainability goals.
- Review of the 5 Rs (refuse, reduce, reuse, recycle, rot).

The Life Cycle of a Water Bottle / Climate Change and You

Week 2

- The pre- and post-consumer impact of a water bottle.
- An explanation of climate change, it's impacts, and the part we play.

Anatomy of a MRF / Anatomy of a Compost Pile

Week 3

- How recyclables are sorted by machinery using their physical properties.
- How food scraps become compost.

Environmental Leadership / Your Presentation

Neek 4

- Effects of personal, community, and governmental action.
- Review a customizable presentation and get details about what goes where.
