City of Oakland Construction & Demolition Requirements

Hauling Requirements

Residential property owners, and their general contractors, may self-haul construction and demolition debris **ONLY**

by using their own fixed body trucks and employees (no trailers or debris boxes).

Unless self-hauling as described above owners and contractors must hire **ONLY** haulers with Non-Exclusive Franchise (NEF) issued by the City of Oakland to transport construction & demolition debris (www.oaklandca.gov/resources/rules-for-transporting-construction-and-demolition-debris). This also applies to Tenant Improvements (TI) when the tenant is responsible for the construction project.

Hiring unauthorized haulers (or demolition companies that do not have NEF) may result in fines, penalties or prosecution.

Hire **ONLY** authorized NEF haulers from the City's list of authorized NEF haulers to transport construction & demolition debris.

Curbside Requirements



Residential property owners may not place construction and demolition debris into the recycle or compost carts/bins. Do not place asphalt, concrete, rocks, sand and gravel, or soil into the trash cart/bin.

The following items should be separated from other C&D materials to be recycled or composted:

Recycle Cart/Bin

- Clean paper and cardboard (flatten boxes)
- Plastic containers such as bottles, jugs, and tubs
- Small amount of scrap metal
- Glass bottles and jars

Compost Cart/Bin

- Wood or lumber scraps free of paint, chemicals and nails
- Bundled clean wood may also be picked up using the bulky service (oaklandrecycles.com/bulky)
- Yard debris including grass clippings, branches, leaves, and cut flowers

Common Recycle and Compost Contamination

Oakland needs everyone to do their part to keep trash out of the recycle and compost carts/bins.

Recycle Do's and Don'ts

No plastic bags of any kind. Do not place recyclables in black or clear plastic bags. Empty recyclables into recycle cart/bin and place bags in the trash cart/bin.

No polystyrene containers or packaging. Place in trash cart/bin.

Remember, recycling must be empty, clean, and dry.

Compost Do's and Don'ts

No plastic bags of any kind. Do not place food scraps in plastic bags. TIP: Use a paper bag or reusable container and place directly into your outside container.

No diapers or pet waste. Place in trash cart/bin.

No recyclable plastics or metal. Place in recycle cart/bin.

Common Holiday Recycling Questions

Get ready for the season by knowing where some of these common holiday items go.

RECYCLE THESE:



Paper bags, non-foil wrapping paper, tissue paper, cardboard, glass and hard plastic bottles, tubs and jugs

TRASH THESE:



Foil wrapping paper, bows, ribbons, plastic bags, foam packaging, bubble wrap, broken ornaments, plastic utensils and cups

COMPOST THESE:



Rotted vegetables/fruit, turkey bones, stale fruitcake, food-soiled paper products like uncoated paper plates or napkins



- No stands
 - No decorations
 - No "snow" flocking
- (Flocked trees go to the landfill.)*

Set clean trees at the curb for collection on your regular compost collection day, 12/26/22 to 1/13/23.
