The City of Oakland Environmental Enforcement Officers are working hard to enforce mandatory trash, recycle, and compost collection and stop illegal dumping. Together, we can keep Oakland clean. Know the rules:

- Every business in Oakland must subscribe to enough trash, recycle and compost service to meet weekly generation (Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) 8.28.140). See reverse side for steps and resources to comply with all OMC 8.28 requirements.
- It is unlawful for any person to put trash, recycle, or compost from their business or home in, on top of, or alongside the street litter containers placed in the sidewalk area. Street litter containers are for use by pedestrians depositing small waste carried by them (OMC 8.29.160).
- It is unlawful for any person to illegally dump or improperly dispose of waste matter (OMC 8.11.310).

Are You Using the Right Bag for Your Containers?

Using the wrong bags or liners in your containers can result in your recycling and compost ending up in the landfill. Use the following guide to purchase the correct type of plastic bag.



If you prefer to line your inside container with a bag, empty the contents into your recycle container and put the bag in the trash.







Steps for Business Compliance with City, County and State Compost, Recycle, and Trash Requirements

- 1. Subscribe to trash, compost and recycle collection services.
 - a. Contact WMAC to set up compost and trash service.
 - b. Choose a recycle service provider and sign up for service. For a list of providers visit www.oaklandrecycles.com/services/business/.

- 2. Place color-coded and labeled recycle and compost bins next to all trash bins.
 - a. Visit www.StopWaste.org/Rules-Resources for free tools:
 - Stickers to label bins
 - \$500 to buy indoor green compost bins

 - Recycle station set up guide
 - Training videos



- 3. Sort materials into the proper bins.
- 4. Educate employees, contractors, and tenants about the law at least annually and check bins periodically.
