

Reusable Foodware Ordinance Special Event Rules – Reusable Cups

In Oakland, event producers applying for a Special Event permit for events with over 500 guests per day must implement a Reusable Cup System.



TIMELINE PHASES

Starting July 1, 2025:

 Event producers must replace 25% of unpackaged beverages with a Reusable Cup System

Starting January 1, 2027:

- Event producers must replace 100% of unpackaged beverages with a Reusable Cup System











Unpackaged beverages are those that need to be poured into a container to serve – like wine from a bottle, beer from a keg, or coffee from a dispenser

Reusable Cup System

Reusable Cup Systems



- Use cups that are designed to be washed and sanitized in a commercial dishwasher at least 780 times
- Utilize a convenient customer drop-off system for collection, sanitation, and reuse
- Provide an incentive for customer return of reusable cup

Special Event Permit Application – Waste Reduction Plan (WRP)



- The WRP must describe how you will meet the Reusable Cup System requirements
- The WRP must describe the tracking system to be used to document the total number of beverages sold or provided, and the number of cups used as part of a Reusable Cup System



Special Event Rules – Reusable Cups FREQUENTLY ASKED QUETSIONS

Are events that serve beverages *only* in cans and bottles subject to the reusable cup requirement?

- No. If you do not offer beverages in cups or similar containers, you are not required to use reusable cups.

What types of cups can we use?

 You may use stainless steel, plastic, glass, ceramic or any type of durable material that does not contain a High-Priority Toxic Chemical and is designed for sterilization and reuse at least 780 times (CCR 17989.3).

Do souvenir cups that guests take home satisfy the requirements?

- No. Cups must be collected as part of a Reusable Cup System.

How do I ensure reusable cups are safely used to serve beverages?

- Use of reusable cups must comply with CA Health & Safety Code, Sections 113700 et seq. and all other applicable state and local laws.

How do I <u>document</u> that 25% (100% starting Jan 1, 2027) of beverages are served using a Reusable Cup System?

- Contracts with beverage vendors must include compliance with this ordinance, including a way to document total sales or provision of poured beverages and those served in reusable cups.

How do I <u>submit proof</u> of 25% (100% starting Jan 1, 2027) of beverages are served using a Reusable Cup System?

- Documentation should be submitted to specialevents@oaklandca.gov within three months of your event.

What are the consequences of non-compliance?

- The City of Oakland can issue citations of up to \$500 per violation.
